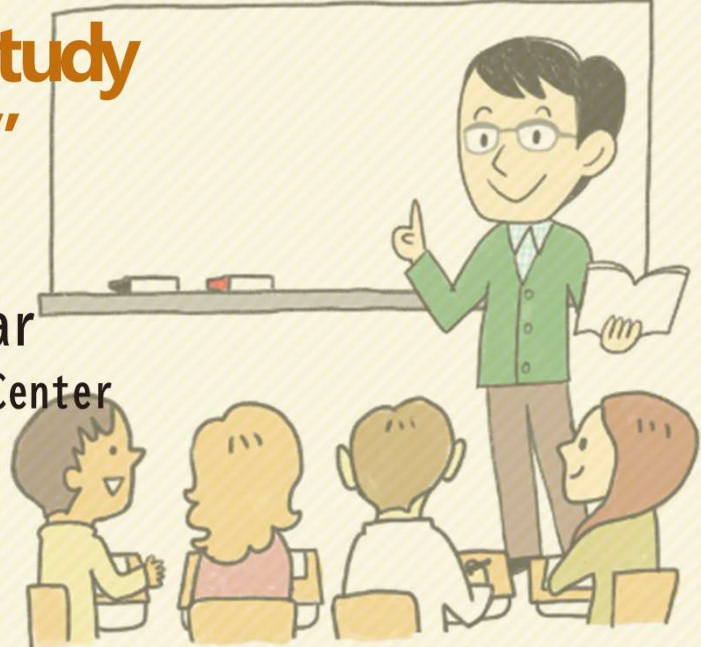


The get-gathering, "Let's study Japanese for nursing care."
